Boy Scout Troop 52 Volunteer Offer: Identifying and mapping trees in Schranz Park and providing characteristics about each tree was suggested.

Unfinished Business: Splash pad. Proposed ordinance will be revised again. A group reservation will require a substantial deposit. One group party left the splash pad with food in the splash area, which clogged the filter system, as well as broken beer bottles. This disabled the use of the splash pad and was a safety hazard for anyone coming into the area. The Village will be adding two summer hires, one of whom will be at Schranz all day. One of his/her duties will be monitoring the splash pad.
